

Soil Testing in Wedgewood Heights

The City of Edmonton is conducting soil tests in September 2014 to evaluate vacant buildings sites in Wedgewood Heights. The soil tests will occur south of Wedgewood Boulevard, near Weber Gate.

City Council approved development of new homes on eight undeveloped surplus school building sites, including one in Wedgewood Heights, to support future seniors' housing. Council directed City staff to explore the option of moving the Wedgewood Heights building site east to 184 Street.

The City is conducting soil tests in September 2014 at the approved and alternate building site locations to help determine whether the alternate location can support the approved development. Results will be posted on the City's website and shared with residents in an open house this fall.

Upcoming Community Information Sessions: Fall 2014

The City will share information with residents and ask for their feedback on the approved and alternative building site. The City will send meeting invitations to Wedgewood residents, the Wedgewood Ravine Homeowners' Association and Wedgewood Ravine Community League when open house details are finalized.
